Aerial Data Analyst

The Role:

Reporting to the Director of Corporate Services, the successful candidate will conduct reviews of client parcels in association with the real property valuation process. Duties typically include comparing current data with oblique and ortho aerial imagery and identifying any property changes, completing all data entry tasks with documenting changes made to parcels, flagging parcels that require further review for field inspections, and reporting any errors in GIS data to the GIS Coordinator.

Key Responsibilities:

- Review and inspect real property data using aerial imagery
- Identify renovations completed on a dwelling and calculate the effective age of the dwelling
- Identify new decks, outbuildings, additions, and other changes to a property
- Update database information on any parcel that requires change
- Review data for properties with no visible changes to ensure accuracy
- Complete property sketches within the CAMA system and ensure that measurements are correct on existing sketches
- Identify, flag and remove properties for field review
- Identify properties requiring a field visit due to obstructed vision, extensive renovations or unclear ownership
- Ensure that GIS data is correct and report any errors to the GIS Coordinator

Screening Criteria:

- High School Diploma supplemented by related training and/or post-secondary education in real property appraisal/assessment, GIS or related field (equivalencies may be considered)
- Experience in the real estate, construction or valuation field
- Experience with computer applications including MS Office and other related software
- Experience interpreting aerial imagery (asset)
- Experience with GIS and surveying (asset)
